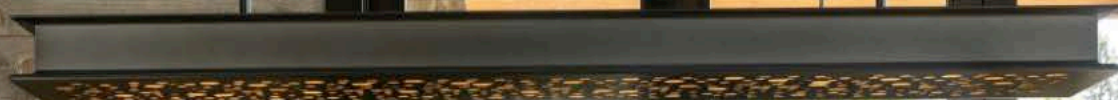
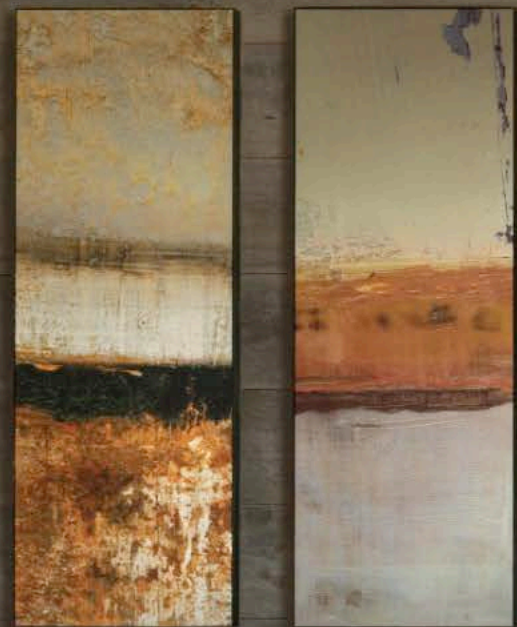

NATURAL WONDER

COLLECTIVE DESIGN and PINNACLE MOUNTAIN HOMES combine a variety of woods with raw metal accents and subtle glints of gold for a mountain showstopper.

IN BRECKENRIDGE, COLORADO, AN ALABAMA COUPLE DECIDED TO BUILD A RUSTIC MOUNTAIN RETREAT. WITH A VERY GOOD SENSE OF WHAT THEY WANTED, THEY ENGAGED COLLECTIVE DESIGN BASED IN FRISCO, COLORADO. ONE OF THE DESIGNERS FOR THE PROJECT, NICOLE BRUNO, TEAMED UP WITH THE GROUP'S SISTER COMPANY, PINNACLE MOUNTAIN HOMES, TO CREATE A 6500 SQUARE FOOT HOME FEATURING HIS-AND-HER SUITES, FOUR GUEST ROOMS, AND A KIDS' BUNK ROOM. SEEING THE UNIQUE OPPORTUNITY BEFORE THEM, COLLECTIVE DESIGN CREATED A HOME THAT EMBRACES RECLAIMED WOOD, NATURAL MATERIALS, AND CUSTOM PIECES AND FINISHES.

GRAND ENTRANCE

A custom steel and walnut door open to a large foyer and a built-in walnut bench with a live edge. The walls and floors are clad in stone and a variety of wood finishes.

STARTING AT THE ENTRANCE, THE FRONT DOOR IS A CUSTOM-BUILT, EIGHT-FOOT DOOR IN WALNUT AND STEEL. RECLAIMED WOOD AND STEEL ARE PRESENT THROUGHOUT MOST OF THE HOME. THE FEEL IS RUSTIC BUT THROUGH A MODERN LENS... AND PERFECTLY SUITED FOR A MOUNTAIN RETREAT.

MANY OF THE ITEMS IN THE DESIGN WERE CUSTOM MADE FOR THE COUPLE, INCLUDING THE SUBDUED BUT SPECTACULAR LIGHT FIXTURE IN THE DINING AREA. THE COUPLE WANTED THE FIXTURE TO FEEL LIKE LOOKING AT THE CONSTELLATIONS. THE DESIGN TEAM CAME UP WITH A CLEVER FIXTURE IN STEEL THAT IS PERFORATED WITH SMALL HOLES AND LIT FROM ABOVE. THE RESULT IS LIKE HAVING DINNER UNDER THE OPEN MOUNTAIN SKY.

THERE ARE DELIGHTFUL SURPRISES AND CUSTOM TOUCHES THROUGHOUT THE HOME. ON THE LOWER LEVEL, A BILLIARDS ROOM FEATURES A WET BAR WITH A COUNTER MADE OF RECLAIMED WOOD FROM AN OLD TRAILER BED. EACH ROOM HAS A UNIQUE DESIGN, BUT THE TEAM AT COLLECTIVE DESIGN HAS MASTERFULLY MANAGED TO MAINTAIN A COHESIVE LOOK THROUGHOUT THE HOME.

CLEVER AND COOL

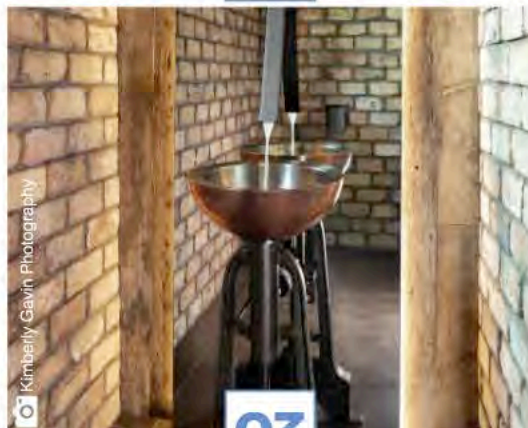
Custom design is present throughout the rustic yet modern mountain project. Here brick walls and rough wood are the backdrop for a wash basin with a unique faucet.
